

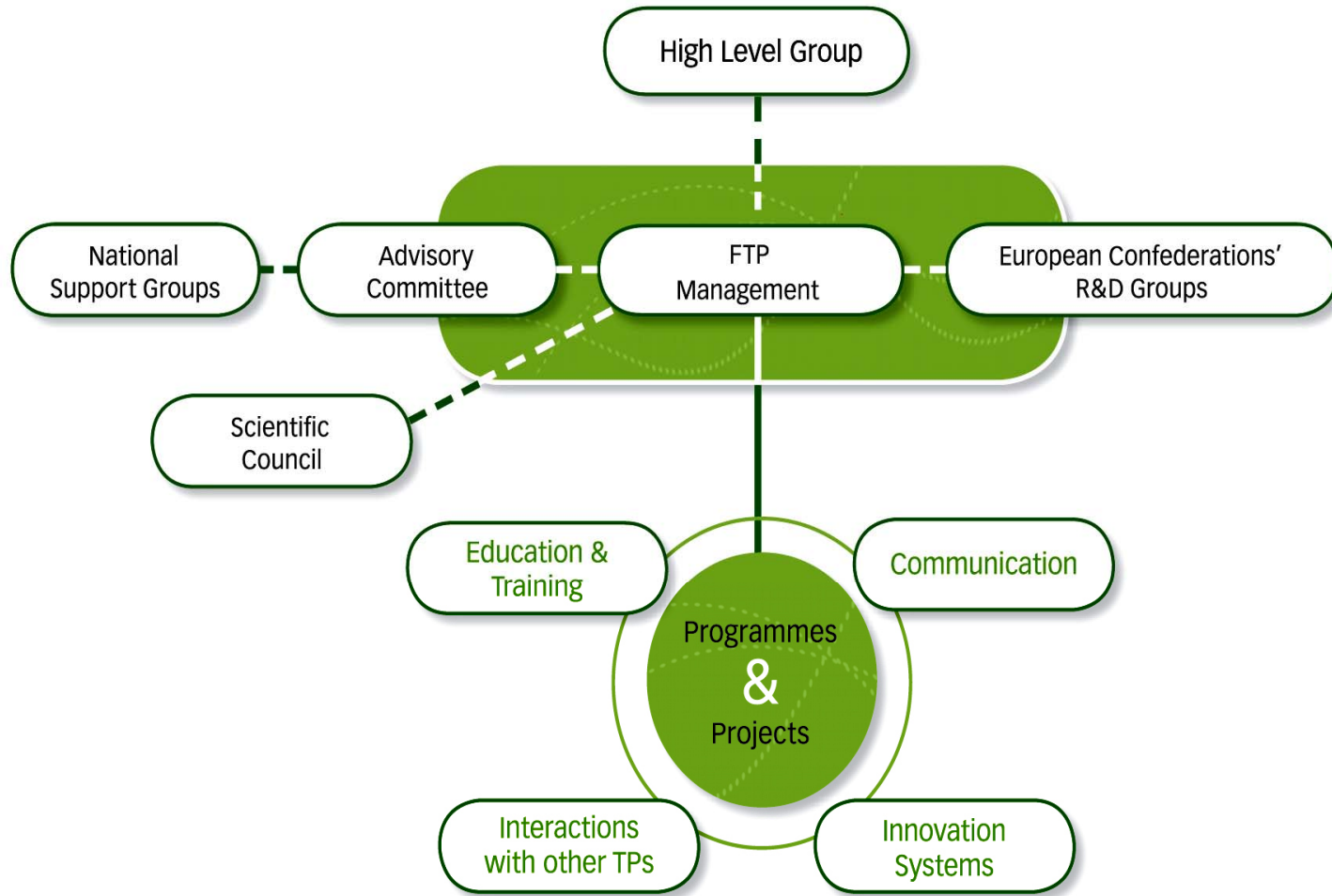
Implementation – Stockholm Nov. 2005

- ▶ Development of the SRA into research programs and projects
- ▶ Coordination of the European SRA with national agendas
- ▶ Development of schemes for research funding
- ▶ Create networks, consortia, etc for future research activities
- ▶ Connect the SRA with appropriate existing research efforts

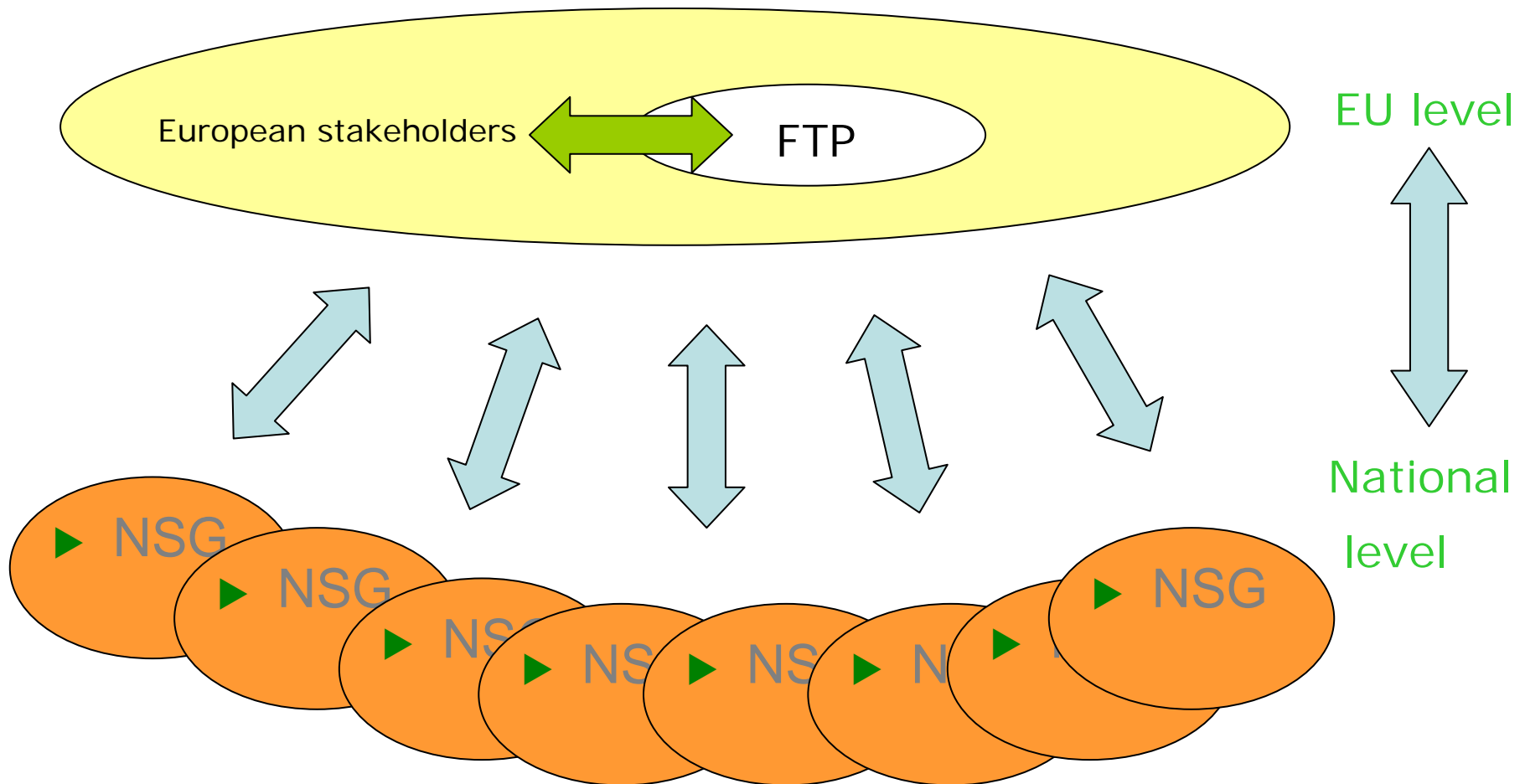
What will FTP do next?

- ▶ On European level
 - an Action Plan and a Communication Plan
 - have a dialogue with EU Commission and Parliament
 - stimulate National Support Groups (NSG)
 - facilitate research consortia, cooperation with other platforms and funding initiatives
- ▶ On national level through NSGs
 - promote realisation of SRA through national confirmation
 - coordinate national agendas and their funding
 - secure involvement of key stakeholders
- ▶ Mobilise research community

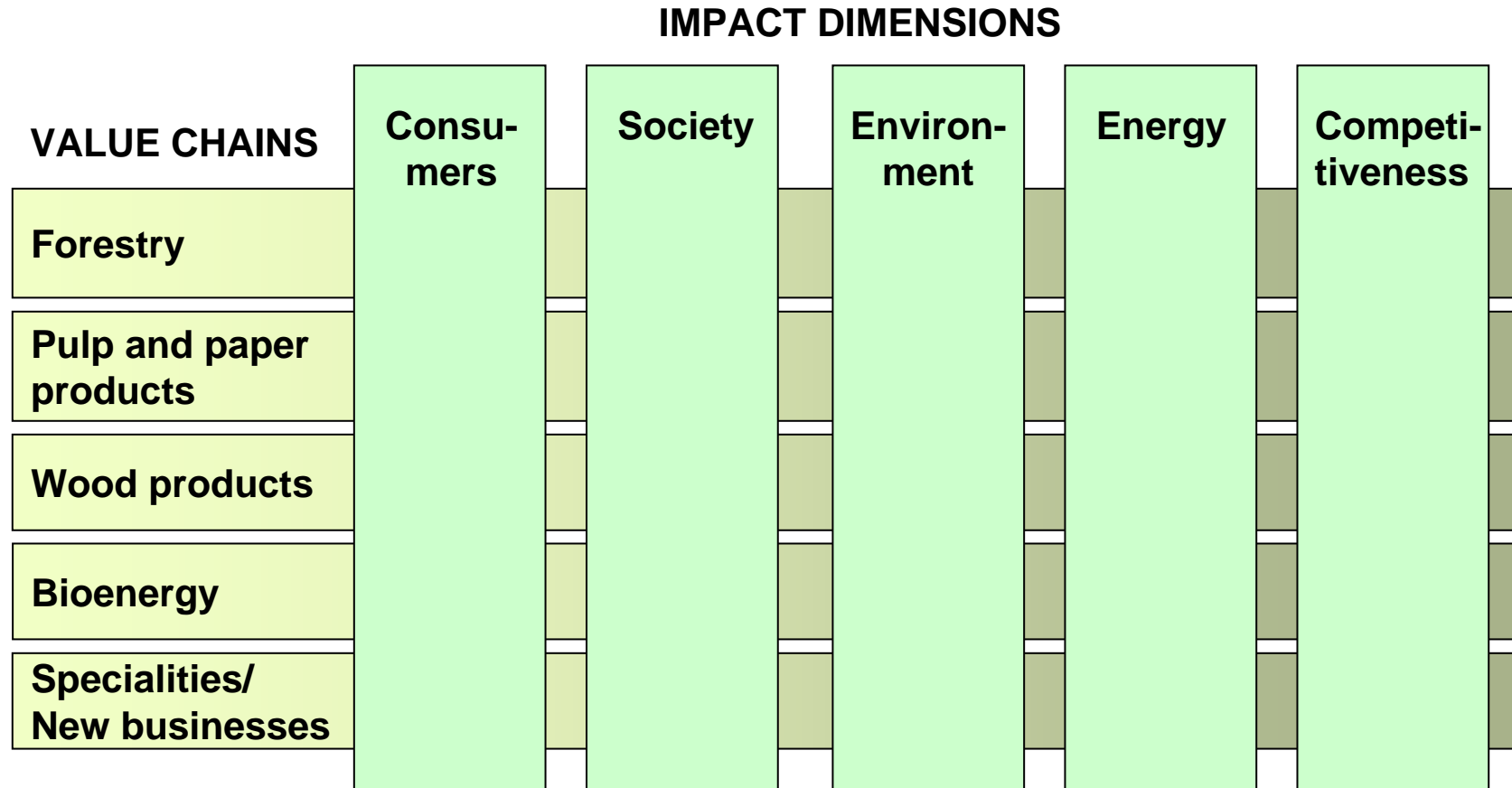

The SRA Development process



Value chain representation

- ▶ Secure closer links to European federations, research associations and industry
- ▶ Participate in monitoring and reviewing the SRA process
- ▶ Provide access to core competence
- ▶ Participate in the prioritization process related to the Action Plan
- ▶ Secure the industrial contribution to the SRA process
- ▶ Evaluate the industrial impact of upcoming project proposals
- ▶ Contribute to dissemination, communication education and training
- ▶ Support FTP management

Value chain representation (proposal)

- ▶ Forestry – CEPF + “large scale forest owner” + EFI
- ▶ Wood Products – CEI-Bois + Innovawood
- ▶ Pulp & Paper – CEPI + EFPRO
- ▶ Bio-energy – under consideration
- ▶ Specialities – under consideration

Scientific Council

- ▶ Review the Action Plan
- ▶ Secure an holistic approach in the SRA process
- ▶ Support strategic workshops and consortia
- ▶ Liaise with other Technology Platforms, networks and instruments (COST actions, ERA-Net etc.)
- ▶ Promote the participation of a broader spectrum of scientists and emerging technologies into FTP
- ▶ Evaluate the scientific value of cooperation outside of Europe
- ▶ Chairman – Yves Birot, France

A look to the future – summing-up

- ▶ Develop an Action Plan and a Communication Plan
- ▶ Secure participation of key stakeholders specifically the industry
- ▶ Mobilize the National Support Groups
- ▶ Keep the Forest-Based Sector together
- ▶ Interact with other Technology Platforms
- ▶ Promote Innovation, Education and Training and include it in the Action Plan
- ▶ Secure transparency and involvement
